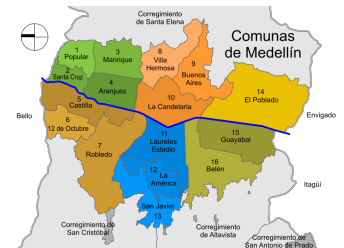

NEW PROJECTS

We have been wanting to share some exciting new projects with you for the last few months, but we have held off until things were firmly rolling. Now we can finally tell you all about it!

Comuna 13 is a sector in the western side of the city of Medellín. From the first day we set foot in this part of the city we felt a connection to the people and sensed that it would become an important part of our ministry. Over the last couple of years we have often gone to Comuna 13 to do kids programs and help churches in the area. Earlier this year we sensed it was time to open a new chapter in our ministry and everything aligned for us to take on two projects that focus specifically on this part of the city.



Comuna 13, also known as San Javier, is in the western section of Medellín.



The Church Project

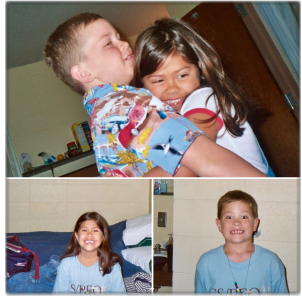

We have been meeting in a community room and are currently trying to secure a more permanent place to rent. Last Sunday we had 57 people in attendance. It is growing quickly and we are expecting growth to continue.

We are partnering with a Christian soccer school in order to help the families that are most in crisis and need immediate help.
