PRAY FOR COLOMBIA

This has been a very difficult time for Colombia. A Covid wave has left hospitals at over 100% capacity. In Medellín, sixty hotel rooms were rented out and converted into hospital rooms to help with the overflow of patients. There is civil unrest throughout the country. Torrential downpours have caused severe flooding and damage in Medellín. Colombia needs prayer. Please pray for our churches as they address the needs and concerns of their communities. Pray for healing and peace.



PRAYER TOUR

Before we returned to the States, Corey felt God leading him to travel to the Assemblies of God churches in Georgia and Michigan and pray over their property, for their influence, and for their needs. He felt he should never ask a church to pray for him if he is not willing to do the same. This prayer tour has given him a peaceful time with God and the opportunity to intercede for others. On his tour, he has visited, prayed and left a note of encouragement for the pastors. He has prayed onsite at nearly 200 churches.

Despite an ongoing pandemic and continued lockdowns in Colombia, our team has been able to get into Comuna 13 a few times over the last few months. Thanks to our supporters and the local food bank, they were able to give out groceries and gifts to families. They were also able to open to feed the children in the community on a few occasions.

GRADUATION

At the end of April we had the opportunity to celebrate Tona's graduation from Southwestern Assemblies of God University with a Master or Arts in Organizational Leadership. Her parents were able to attend the graduation and celebrate with her. This past December, she also completed training with Emerge Counseling as a Certified Leadership Coach. The knowledge she acquired through both of these programs will help her in ministry as she continues to mentor children's ministry leaders, new missionaries as our team grows, and with the organization and administration of the community center team. She will also be a resource for churches in the States and Colombia when they seek the help of a leadership coach to bring alignment in their ministry teams.

KAUTZ KIDS

After being furloughed through Covid, Alex has been able to return to his jobs at Disney and Discovery Cove. Maggie has just started working for the State of Georgia Department of Family and Children Services. Both have been able to use their skills in Spanish to help people in difficult situations. We are so proud of both of them and grateful that we have the peace of knowing they are doing well as we prepare to return to the field.
