Adult GED Program

We opened a program to help adults finish their high school education. We were a little overwhelmed when more than 100 people from 16 to 74 years old signed up. About half of the initial group has stuck with the program and will graduate in February. We are getting ready to open a second group in August.

Soccer

Twice a week, Corey and four of our male volunteers work with a group of nearly 60 kids playing soccer. Currently the group is all boys, with the exception of one girl. The leaders take time to teach about integrity, respect, and how loved the children are. Many of the kids do not have a male figure in their household. We have seen a beautiful response in several of the kids who started with behavioral issues that with time and love have resolved.

Children's Feeding Program

Also twice a week we serve lunch to 30 to 40 children. It started one week when a couple of kids were hanging around while we were eating. One of our volunteers made plates for the children. The next week a few more came, and it continued to grow. Now we are busting at the seams and looking for partners to help us expand and feed more children throughout the whole week. We started with just a sink and a rice cooker. We are currently renovating the kitchen area and have added a stove, refrigerator and lots of utensils
